LaTara presented pricing and ideas for additional purchases from Sam's Club for the snack sale. Lastly, she presented the idea that we should start a food donation box to collect non-perishable food items for the needy during the holidays. She will obtain approval from the Department Secretary for placement of the box in the Sociology Dept. office. The donated food will possibly be donated to the Second Harvest Food Bank or other source.
